This week's Catechism # 31

What do we believe by true faith?

Everything taught to us in the gospel. The Apostles' Creed expresses what we believe in these words: We believe in God the Father Almighty, Maker of heaven and earth; and in Jesus Christ his only Son our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried. He descended into the grave. The third day he rose again from the dead. He ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of God the Father Almighty; from there he will come to judge the living and the dead. We believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy Christian church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting

Next week's Catechism # 32

What do justification and sanctification mean?

Justification means our declared righteousness before God, made possible by Christ's death and resurrection for us. *Sanctification* means our gradual, growing righteousness, made possible by the Spirit's work in us.

A Word from Pastor Scott: Sunday August 2, 2020

The Father loves the Son and has given all things into his hand. Whoever believes in the Son has eternal life; whoever does not obey the Son shall not see life, but the wrath of God remains on him.

John 3:35-36

It's clear from a passage like John 3:30-36 that the Christian faith and life are all about Jesus! Salvation, life, eternal happiness, wisdom, grace – all these things are tied to Him and come to us from Him. That's why we ended last time with John's words in **Jn 3:30**, "*He must increase, but I must decrease!*" That simple statement gives us the core truth for all Christian living and daily sanctification. There must be "*more of Jesus and less of me*" in me each day!

So how are you doing with that? At home? At work? Online? Have you seen your need for more of Him? Are you looking to Him for what He alone can supply, so that you are seeking Him daily and consciously walking in His grace! That is the Christian life! It is a life that is more and more oriented to Jesus, more and more filled with Him and satisfied in Him as we draw life from Him the way a branch draws its life and fruitfulness from the vine!
