# A Word from Pastor Scott Sunday December 13, 2020

"She will bear a son, and you shall call his name Jesus, for He will save His people from their sins."- Matthew 1:21

"He will save His People from their sins!" That's the good news of Christmas we're here to celebrate! We know that Jesus came to save us, but from what? From our sins! – from our God-denying, small-minded, earth-is-all-I-care-about meaningless, wasted lives where we flitter away 70 or 80 years for nothing more than money or sex or luxuries or houses and lands or vacations and entertainment and fame, or whatever else you might try to use to get some sense of satisfaction out of your temporary life!
