A Word from Pastor Scott February 7, 2021

Jesus answered, "My teaching is not mine, but his who sent me.

If anyone's will is to do God's will, he will know whether the teaching is from God or whether I am speaking on my own authority.

John 7:16-17

As we return to John 7, we find that the controversy surrounding Jesus just continues to heat up. His life and teaching have again clashed with the world around Him. That always seems to happen! Human society apart from Christ can't handle Him because He won't play their games. He won't yield to their pressure. He won't hedge the truth and tell us what we want to hear. No, He always insists on speaking the truth of God we need to hear!

But if there's anything mankind in its arrogance can't stand, it's having to face the truth about who we are. So it comes down to a question of authority! Who does Jesus think He is that we should listen to Him?

And of course, dear friend, that's always the question isn't it? Is Jesus really who He claims to be or is He not? If He is, then nothing could be more important than hearing His word, yielding to it, believing it and obeying it! If Jesus is Who He claims to be, then His word is your one hope of knowing God and living eternally. If not, then none of this really matters and frankly nothing really matters because soon you will die and that will be the end of it. If Christ is not our hope for in this life *and* the life to come, then truly there is no hope

So it matters very much that we understand the authority of Jesus, both in what He says and in what He does. For if He is Who He claims to be (and I'm convinced He is), then we must be ready not only to hear Him eagerly, but also to believe everything He says and be ready to obey all He commands.

My prayer this morning is that you will come with a ready, listening ear and a willing, submissive heart to receive His word for the joy of your soul.
