Confession based on Psalm 62

Pastor: For God alone my soul waits in silence:

from him comes my salvation.

Cong: He alone is my rock and my salvation, my fortress; I shall not be greatly shaken.

P: How long will all of you attack a man to batter him, like a leaning wall, a tottering fence? They only plan to thrust him down from his high position.

They take pleasure in falsehood. They bless with their mouths, but

inwardly they curse.

C: For God alone, O my soul, wait in silence, for my hope is from him. He alone is my rock and my salvation, my fortress; I shall not be shaken. On God rests my salvation and my glory; my mighty rock, my refuge is in God.

P: Trust in him at all times. O people: pour out your heart before him; God is a refuge for us. Those of low estate are but a breath: those of high estate are a delusion: in the balances they go up; they are together lighter than a breath. Put no trust in extortion; set no vain hopes on robbery; if riches increase, set not your heart on them.

C: Once God has spoken; twice have I heard this: that power belongs to God, and that steadfast love belongs to you, O Lord. For you will render to a man according to his work.
