## A Word from Pastor Warren

Sunday March 26, 2023

"Worthy are you to take the scroll and to open its seals, for you were slain, and by your blood you ransomed people for God from every tribe and language and people and nation..."

Revelation 5:9

Over the last few weeks, Pastor Scott has walked us through John's record of the crucifixion of Christ, showing us how Jesus was sovereign even in his suffering. He was working out a plan that would stretch out from that little hill outside Jerusalem to reach the whole world as, by his death, he purchased a people from every tribe and tongue and nation.

One of the joys we have as a church is celebrating the global reach of God's kingdom through missions. We want to be eager to pray, give, and go to make Jesus known around the world.

This spring, Pastor Scott will have the opportunity to join in this global work personally. Our friends at HeartCry Missionary Society have asked him to travel to Romania for ten days in May (5/9-5/20). During this time, he will meet with our missionary partners, preach and teach in multiple contexts (discipleship, evangelistic meetings, church services), and get a fresh view of the work God is doing in Romania - including the grand opening of a new chapel in the gypsy village of Zizin! One of our deacons, Scott Larson, will be joining Pastor Scott on the trip, since the foundation he serves was instrumental in helping construct the chapel.

As we reflect on the death of Jesus, we remember that, while we are saved individually (cf. Gal 2:20), we are not saved alone. Jesus died for his bride, his body, his Church. We are united with brothers and sisters around the world and are eager to see them built up in the truth.

Please pray for both Scott Lee and Scott Larson. Pray for safety, health, and spiritual power as they minister in various ways. Pray for mutual encouragement as they meet with missionary partners like the Tomeci, Palada, Prodan, and Babb families. Also, since we did not anticipate this trip with a budgetary line item, if you feel led to partner financially, you can designate a gift for "Pastor's Mission Trip" (Scott Larson's travel is covered by the aforementioned foundation).
