#### A Word from Pastor Scott:

Sunday March 5, 2023

"Therefore, I exhort the elders among you, as your fellow elder and witness of the sufferings of Christ, and a partaker also of the glory that is to be revealed, shepherd the flock of God among you, exercising oversight not under compulsion, but voluntarily, according to the will of God; and not for sordid gain, but with eagerness;

#### 1 Pet 5:1-2

It is our joy, today, to share together in the service of ordination for our brother, Warren Kesselring, as he begins his "official" service as one of the elders at Rockport Baptist Church. If you know anything about Baptist tradition, you know that such "ordinations" usually takes place in a "special service" on a Sunday afternoon or evening. We have chosen to make this a more central event in the life of our church by holding it as a part of our regular morning worship. Our reasons for doing so are as follows:

- (1) We want this to be a time of celebration and instruction for the whole church family rather than for the limited few who would be able to come back for a "special" service later in the day.
- (2) We view this as a time for the whole congregation, both leaders and members, to join together in confirming our brother's call to pastoral ministry. [Traditionally, one reason such ordinations were held in the afternoon was to make it possible for pastors and deacons from other congregations to attend and help form an "ordination counsel" to question and confirm the candidate. Such counsels are rare today.]
- (3) We believe this should be a worship service focused on Christ and his gifts and callings to the church, rather than a service focused on any particular man being ordained. Warren, Kyle and I agree the focus needs to be on Christ alone any time the church gathers. So Lord willing, that's what we will do this morning as we join our brother in rejoicing in God's calling and setting him aside to serve us all here at Rockport Baptist Church!
