A Word from Pastor Scott:

It is our joy to welcome missionary Paul Snider back with us this morning. Paul and his wife Trish first visited us several years ago as they were preparing to begin their work among the Northern Korowai people of Indonesia in 2012. As many of you know, Paul was supposed to be with us again last summer, but was unable to do so due to a serious relapse of jungle related illnesses contracted during his service in Indonesia, especially the Chikungunya virus and other misquote born illnesses. Due to the debilitating pain and other difficulties caused by these illnesses, that visit had to be canceled as we and several other churches sought the Lord for Paul's recovery.

The Lord had mercy on Paul so that he has recovered significantly and been able to return for a brief time to Indonesia to inspect the state of the work there and encourage the churches and leaders the Lord has raised up among this people group. Paul and Trish are now preparing to return to Indonesia on a more permanent basis, but Paul has taken time out to visit with us this morning. (Please pray for Trish who had planned to be with him, but had to return home to care for her mother.)

As you will hear today, the Sniders have seen the Lord bring many to faith in Christ, church's established and strengthened and the process of translating the Bible and other vital literature into the Korowai language begun. Most recently they have finished work translating and making an audior recording of the "Northern Korowai Salvation History Catechism" which they have now distributed to the Korowai people along with solar-powered mp3 players so they can listen. We look forward to hearing from Paul so we can better pray and support what the Lord is doing. Please do pray for Paul and Trish and their two children, Lane and Marianne.
