A Word from Pastor Scott Sunday October 29, 2023

"I am not ashamed of the gospel, for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes . . . as it is written, "The righteous shall live by faith."

Rm 1:16-17

These words stunned a young monk named Martin just a little over 500 years ago. He had been taught by his church that salvation came through his own efforts to be righteous by doing good and trying his best to keep the laws and commands of the church. And try he did, as hard as any man ever could. He fasted. He prayed. He wept. He confessed his sins daily – even hourly. Yet still he was plagued with doubt and tormented by the guilt of his sin. It nearly drove him insane! How could he, a sinner, ever hope to be righteous in the eyes of God! That was his problem and he knew it. He knew that God was holy and he was sinful. He understood that even if he managed to purge most of the sin from his life (if that was even possible!) and came to the place where he was righteous 98% of the time with only 2% sin remaining, he would still fall short of God's requirement of perfect righteousness. So what could he do? When urged by his superiors that he must simply "love God", in agony of soul he cried out,"Love God? Sometimes I think I hate Him!"

But God had mercy on young Martin. He was assigned the task of teaching others the New Testament. It was there in the study of Romans that God opened his eyes to see the simple, life-giving truth of the Gospel – that God gives the righteousness He requires freely, as a gift, to all who put their faith in Christ alone to save them. Not by works! Not by religion! Not by morality or self-effort! Not through ritual! But by grace alone through faith in Christ alone, sinners can be saved! That realization changed everything for Martin Luther and led to the Reformation which soon spread the good news around the world. That good news continues to change all who look to Christ by faith alone. Has it changed you? Have you turned from your sin and self-effort to trust in Christ?

May God give us all a "Luther moment" of seeing Christ by faith alone!
