A Word from Pastor Scott Sunday December 24, 2023 – Christmas Eve

"She will bear a son, and you shall call his name Jesus, for He will save His people from their sins."- Matthew 1:21

"He will save His People from their sins!" That's the good news of Christmas we're here to celebrate this morning! Jesus came to save us, but from what? From our sins! From our Goddenying, small-minded, earth-is-all-l-care-about, meaningless, wasted lives where we flitter away 70 or 80 years for nothing more than money or sex or luxuries or houses and lands and vacations and beauty and fame or whatever else you might come up with in an attempt to satisfy that empty place in your soul!
