Pastor: *Now I would remind you, brothers (and sisters),*

*of the gospel I preached to you, which you received, in which you  
stand, and by which you are being saved, if you hold fast to the  
word I preached to you— unless you believed in vain. For I  
delivered to you as of first importance what I also received:*

**Congregation: ...that Christ died for our sins**

**in accordance with the Scriptures, that he was buried, that he  
was raised on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures,  
(1 Cor 15:1-3)**

*P: For God made him who had no sin to be sin for us, that in him we  
might become the righteousness of God. (2 Corinthians 5:21)*

**C: For while we were still helpless, at the right time Christ died for  
the ungodly. (Romans 5:6)**

*P: Surely he has borne our griefs and carried our sorrows; yet we  
esteemed him stricken, smitten by God, and afflicted. (Isa 53:4)*

**C: But God demonstrates his love for us in this:**

**While we were still sinners, Christ died for us. (Rom 5:8)**

*P: He was pierced for our transgressions; He was crushed for our  
iniquities; The chastisement that brought us peace fell on him, and

## A Word from Pastor Scott:

Sunday January 14, 2024

*"Now I would remind you, brothers, of the gospel I preached to you,  
which you received, in which you stand."*

**1 Corinthians 15:1**

Most of you are aware that we as a church face a number of important decisions about how we should respond to the good things the Lord has been doing among us through His faithfulness to His word. God continues to bring new people to us who are longing for Christ-centered worship along with the faithful exposition of His Word and genuine fellowship. As a result, we are growing as a church. And that's a good thing! But it also presents challenges.

With that in mind, one major point of discussion at our recent elder's retreat was our need to clarify what must not change about our church as we grow. So what is it that cannot change? First of all, our basic mission to be faithful to Christ and His Gospel cannot change. In our mission statement we declare that *"Rockport Baptist Church exists to spread the Good News of God's Sovereign Grace for the Joy of all who believe."* That's central to our identity. We are a rescued people who exist to worship our Savior and proclaim Him faithfully to others so they too may join us as His disciples. At the center of that identity are five values that express our commitment as to how we will remain faithful to Christ and His Word. Those values are as follows: *We are committed to...*

**Truth that Transforms Our Lives** (Faithfulness to His Word)

**Worship that Centers on Christ** (Faithfulness to Honor Him!)

**Fellowship that Binds Us Together in Love** (Faithfulness to One Another)

**Prayer that Expresses Our Dependence on God** (Submission to Him)

**Mission that Shapes our Lives for God's Glory** (All in Service to Him)

There is a lot that needs to be unpacked in these statements. Lord willing, we will do that in series of messages in February. But for now, just know that no matter what must change, our commitment to Christ and His word never will!
