

Sunday June 16, 2024

³¹ "Therefore a man shall leave his father and mother and hold fast to his wife, and the two shall become one flesh." ³² This mystery is profound, and I am saying that it refers to Christ and the church. ³³ However, let each one of you love his wife as himself, and let the wife see that she respects her husband.

Ephesians 5:31-33

I've been thinking about these verses this week for a couple of reasons. The first has to do with weddings. Weddings have always been a great feature of our life together at Rockport.
