■ Confession / Lord's Supper - CONFESSION FROM ROMANS 14:1-23

(congregational readings in bold)

- (lead) Father, as we gather in the name of Jesus, we confess our unity with all saints in all ages. Yet, while differences remain among us, we confess we sometimes fixate on forcing others to conform to our opinions. Remind us to whom we answer.
- (cong) Each of us will give an account of himself to God.
- (lead) We confess our tendency to focus on rules and externals. Some of these flow from good principles, yet we fixate on the form and forget the substance.

- (cong) For the kingdom of God is not a matter of eating and drinking but of righteousness and peace and joy in the Holy Spirit.
- (lead) Our fixation on others and external rules leaves us conflicted, and we let this conflict excuse our acting contrary to the conviction of our consciences. We confess this as faithless and evil.
- (cong) For whatever does not proceed from faith is sin.
- (lead) If you, O Lord, should mark iniquity, who could stand? Yet with you there is forgiveness. The child of God stands not in his righteousness, but in the righteousness of Christ.
- (cong) And he will be upheld, for the Lord is able to make him stand. Amen.


