Those who are interested in seeking membership are asked to make this known to Pastor Scott and/or an Elder who will provide a copy of our Petition for Membership and explain the process.

Why Should I Be Baptized?

Baptism is commanded by Christ (Matthew 28:18-20) for all those who would follow Him as disciples. It is a picture on the outside of what Christ does on the inside of all those who come to Him by faith. As Paul declares in Romans 6:4, "We are buried with Him through baptism into death, and raised to walk in newness of life." Baptism, therefore symbolizes our new life in Christ as believers. It is a public declaration that my old life is dead and I now belong to him. As such, it is the first act of obedience for all who would profess their faith in Him for salvation. *My little children, for whom I am again in the anguish of childbirth

Galatians 4:19

You ever had a song get stuck in your head and, no matter what you did, you just couldn't get it to stop? This verse has been like that song playing in my mind all week. I just haven't been able to shake it! And the more it has played in my mind, the more I have realized I just couldn't go any further in the study of Galatians until I stopped to listen to what this verse is saying. For I believe there is something very important here that God wants us to see.

The part that has been stuck in my head is found in those final five words of Gal 4:19, “...until Christ is formed in you.” What is that? That's Paul's declaration of what a disciple really is – what a Christian really is. A Christian is not just a person who has believed Christ and is forgiven of their sins, though it certainly starts there and is truly wonderful! But a Christian is something more! A Christian is someone in whom Christ now dwells through faith (Gal 2:20; Col 1:27). And because Christ lives in the Christian's heart and life through faith (Eph 3:17), a powerful new work has begun in the Christian's life. The Christian is being re-made in the image of Christ! The new birth has led to a new life! The old is set aside and something new has begun! And the new that has begun is nothing less than the very life of Christ Himself alive in us, forming and reshaping us into His image for His glory!

That's what we want to look at this morning. God's goal in your salvation is not JUST to keep you out of hell – as wonderful and reassuring as that is! But God has a bigger purpose He is pursuing, and that is to make you like Christ. Christ-likeness is the God-glorifying goal of all He is doing in you now! And this is for your good and His glory! But because this is His purpose for your life, it must also become the purpose you are pursuing for your life as well.

This morning, we consider what it means that Christ is formed in you
