■ Confession / Lord's Supper – <u>Confession from 1 Corinthians 10</u> (lead) For I do not want you to be unaware, brothers, that our fathers were all baptized into Moses, all ate the same spiritual food and drank the same spiritual drink.

- (cong) Nevertheless, with most of them God was not pleased, for they were overthrown in the wilderness.
- (lead) These stories are sobering reminders of the danger of immorality, discontent, and other forms of idolatry. How should we respond?
- (cong) Let anyone who thinks that he stands take heed lest he fall.
- (lead) Are our temptations unique and , thus, excusable?
- (cong) No temptation has overtaken you that is not common to man. Fully human, Jesus faced all these and never gave in.
- (lead) What must we remember when we feel pressed beyond our ability to endure?
- (cong) God is faithful. He will not let us be tempted beyond our ability but with the temptation He will also provide the way of escape.
- (lead) What if we do sin?
- (cong) If anyone does sin, we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous. If we confess our sin, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sin and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.


