Confession -The Law

- (lead) Father, all Scripture is breathed-out by you. This includes the law, which is described, even in the new covenant, as holy and righteous and good.

Update on St David's Church Property Possibility

We have promised to keep you informed as we consider the possibility of purchasing and moving to the former St David's Catholic Church facility at 2334 Tenbrook Rd. in Arnold. At present, such a move is still in the "possibility" stage as we gather information and seek to determine whether such a move is something we can afford and will be to our advantage as a church as we consider future growth and ministry opportunities.

Here is the latest update:

- We have appointed a team to begin preliminary discussions with the diocese to determine the price at which they will be willing to sell the property which consists of nearly seven acres with a large auditorium, gym, full kitchen, school, offices, ballfields, parking lot and rectory.
- We have been informed that the property has been appraised at 2.1 million, but they are willing to begin negotiations lower than that.
- We have been informed that the process that is needed to "deconsecrate" and sell the property has begun. We do not yet know how long that will take.
- We are in the process of getting our property appraised by mid-June. We know of at least one church that says it would be interested in our property if we determine to sell
- We are in the process of appointing a team to look at the St David's property and determine what changes will be needed to make it work as our new home, and what costs would be involved.
- We are putting together another team to help us think about potential ministry uses of this facility should such a move be made.

• We are praying for the Lord to guide us through this process and put us where he wants us

Next steps:

- Our team will work with their representatives to come to an agreement on the price they would be willing to sell and we would be willing to purchase.
- If a suitable agreement can be reached and the elders still believe this would be a good move, we will report back to you as a church and begin the approval process as a congregation.
- As that process begins, we will call the church to prayer for God's wisdom and will. We will also arrange a time for the whole church to tour the facility and ask questions
- We will put together a specific plan for how the move will be paid for, what to do with our current facility, and what changes we will need to make to the new facility for it to be useful to us.
- We will have the new facility inspected to make sure there are no hidden concerns that need to be addressed, or if there are, they will become part of the negotiation process.
- We will put together a clear plan to be presented to the congregation.
- No move will be made without a presentation of such a plan, a time to ask and receive answers to questions, and finally, a vote of approval by the congregation as led by the elders.

We will continue to keep you informed as this process moves forward. May the Lord give us wisdom and unity as we seek Him about this potential move
